

Grow This Cut Flower Garden Delight


Sturdy perennial flowers are complemented by colorful annual flowers. Cut and cut again!

To Create This Garden, You'll Need:

- A Painted Daisy Mixed (perennial)
- B Shasta Daisy Alaska (perennial)
- C Coreopsis Sunray (perennial)
- D Gypsophila Covent Garden (annual)
- E Snapdragon First Ladies (annual)
- F Alyssum Carpet of Snow (annual)

One packet each is enough to plant approx. 10 sq. ft. For a larger garden (20 sq. ft. or more), you'll need two packets of each flower. You can adapt this design to fit your space.

Plant. Select a sunny area in spring. Dig garden area to 12" deep, remove rocks and weeds, and smooth soil surface. Plant seeds following directions on seed packets. Keep soil moist. When seedlings have several pairs of leaves, thin as

suggested.

Watch Grow. Help your garden thrive by a weekly watering and weeding.

Enjoy! The perennial flowers in this garden may bloom the first year, and will return each year. The annual flowers will bloom

profusely this summer and fall. The more flowers you cut for bouquets, the more you'll have to cut!
